In 2017 George's parents, who live in Redhill, Vicki and James Woodall discovered their son had a tumor. From that moment on George was under the care of the Great Ormond Street Children's Hospital. Vicki and James launched 'George and Giant Pledge' and have set out to raise £1million and have currently raised £674,000.

Vicki, a former Oxted County School student and former member of the Sixth Form, thought it would be an excellent idea to end RAG week with a 'Back to School Disco' and we agreed! This is open to all parents, their family and friends regardless of whether they previously attended Oxted School. The event will be held on **Friday 23 March** in the Main Hall from 7.00pm – 11.30pm.

There will be a DJ, no doubt playing many classics of the past, along with a cash bar and cocktail bar. A photographer will also be on hand to record your evening and take a complimentary photograph of you and your friends.
