Dear Parents and Carers

We believe it is vital to recognise and celebrate the wide range of achievements that contribute to a positive, successful learning community. This rewards newsletter highlights students from across Years 7-11 who have been recognised by staff for their consistent effort, commitment and positive contribution to school life.

To continue building a culture of praise and recognition, we are strengthening two key whole school systems: Golden Tickets and the Oxted Values.

Golden Tickets: Class teachers will award one Golden Ticket every lesson to a student who shows outstanding attitude, effort, or contribution. This ensures that exceptional moments of learning are recognised regularly and consistently across the school.

Oxted Values: Any member of staff can nominate any student, at any time, for demonstrating one of our core Oxted 4R values: Respect, Responsibility, Resilience, and Reflection. These nominations celebrate the positive behaviours and character traits that help students thrive both in and beyond the classroom.

Everyday Stars: Students are nominated by teachers for students who consistently do the right thing; Academic Distinctions for those who have excelled or made significant progress in their subjects; and Homework Rewards, celebrating exceptional effort and dedication beyond the classroom. We also recognise students through tutor awards for Awesome Attitude and Tutor Recognition, alongside pastoral awards that celebrate those who go the Extra Mile, demonstrate Resilience, or earn a High Five for their positive impact on others.

We are incredibly proud of all the students and grateful to staff for taking the time to recognise the many ways our young people demonstrate our values each day. Congratulations to all of our award recipients.
