Year 11 'Set for Success' Programme

As we move into the crucial final months before this year's GCSE examinations, our priority is ensuring every student is fully *set for success*. Below is an overview of the planned interventions and support designed to remove barriers, close gaps, and promote a strong, no-excuses culture of achievement.

Spring Assessment Analysis

Following the assessments, class teachers will deliver personalised feedback outlining each student's strengths and clear areas for development. This will guide and refine students' individual revision plans. Assessment outcomes will also shape lesson content and targeted lunchtime or after-school interventions to address specific knowledge gaps.

Easter Revision

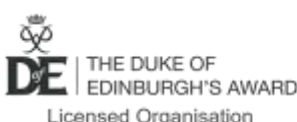
